### Who is EUMOS?

The European Safe Logistics Association – EUMOS – is an independent non-profit association aiming at maximising safety in the logistics chain. EUMOS relies on the exchange of best practices when working on safety standards for logistics in all transport modes. Thanks to the variety of expertise by its members, EUMOS has been instrumental in the elaboration of the Load Safety provisions of Directive 47/2014/EU regarding Road Worthiness Control of Commercial Vehicles which has included the standards EUMOS 40509 and 40511 into its Annex 3. In the interest of ensuring compliance with EU Policy in logistics safety and European and international logistics safety standards, EUMOS has recently initiated the following two projects:

- EUMOS 40607 aims at certifying experts for cargo securing and transport packaging.
- EUMOS 40674 ensures that the responsibility for cargo securing can be followed up via minimum requirements for European cargo safety cards.

EUMOS' members are private and public bodies involved in logistics safety, load stability and cargo securing.
